Psychological Development IN CHILDREN

The word "psychology" means study of mind and "development" means a progressive series of changes that occur in an orderly predictable pattern of maturation and experience. Psychology and Development go hand-in-hand with each other.

Psychology is concerned with the scientific understanding of age related changes in experience and behaviour. There are various definitions of period in a child's development. Since each period is a continuum with individual differences regarding starting and ending some age-related development period and example of defined intervals are New Born (Age 0 to 4 weeks), Infant (Age 4 weeks to 1 year), Toddler (Age 1 year to 3 years), Pre-schooler (Age 4 years to 6 years), School Aged Child (Age 6 years to 13 years), Adolescent (Age 13 years to 19 years).

Promoting child development through parental training among other factors promotes excellent rates of child development. Parents play a large role in a child's life, socialization and development. Another influential factor in a child's development is the quality of their "Child Care". Child Care programmes present a critical opportunity for the promotion of child development. During their pre-school age (3 to 5 years) they enlarge their "social horizons" to include people outside the family. The motor skills of pre-schoolers develop so that they can do more things for themselves. They become more independent. During this age (3 to 5 years) "Play" is most effective activity where a child reaches higher level of cognitive development. Pre-school places the world in front of the children and gives strength.

So "Jean Piaget" says, "Child is a little scientist, exploring and reflecting on these exploration to increase competence and this is done in a very independent way."


ADVANTAGES OF CYCLING
